Reasons for Modernization


- Opened October 1992 27 years ago
- Was primarily connecting traffic USAir hub
- Built for 32 million passengers
- Landside terminal incorrectly configured for today's needs
- Maintenance costs aging equipment

PIT Today Passengers Up / Airline Costs Down


Passengers

Components of TMP

- Overall concept development landside terminal, parking, rental car facilities, etc.
- New landside terminal
- Terminal wayfinding
- Renovation of the existing airside concourses
- New parking garage and Ground Transportation Center
- Overall site design, including landscaping
- Infrastructure design to support roadways, bridges and certain surfaces
- Parking lots



Well-Defined Project Delineation

Landside Components (Turner Construction)

- Parking Garage (Ingress and Egress)
- Close-In, Long-Term Surface Parking Lot
- Commercial Vehicle Surface Parking Lot
- Ground Transportation Center (GTC)
- Rental Car "Ready Return" Parking Lot
- Rental Car Quick-Turn-Around (QTA) Facility

Construction Packages Timeline Overview*

- Early Works / Site Preparation Packages Bids: September 2019 January 2020
- Ceremonial Groundbreaking: October 2019
- Construction Documents Developed: 2Q 2020
- Bidding and Negotiation of terminal construction packages phased through 3Q & 4Q 2020
- Naming of prime contractors expected in mid-to-late 2020
- Construction of landside terminal and new parking garage: late 2020 2023
- Grand Opening 2023

Contractual and Insurance Requirements



Contractual & Insurance Requirements

- Once contract is awarded (for Professional Services), negotiations will begin with regard to scope of work and fees.
- Insurance coverage will also be negotiated with the exception of the statutorily mandated coverages.
- ACAA has contracted with Alliant for an Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP) to streamline processes and site safety.
- Administrative Action is submitted to the ACAA Board for approval.




