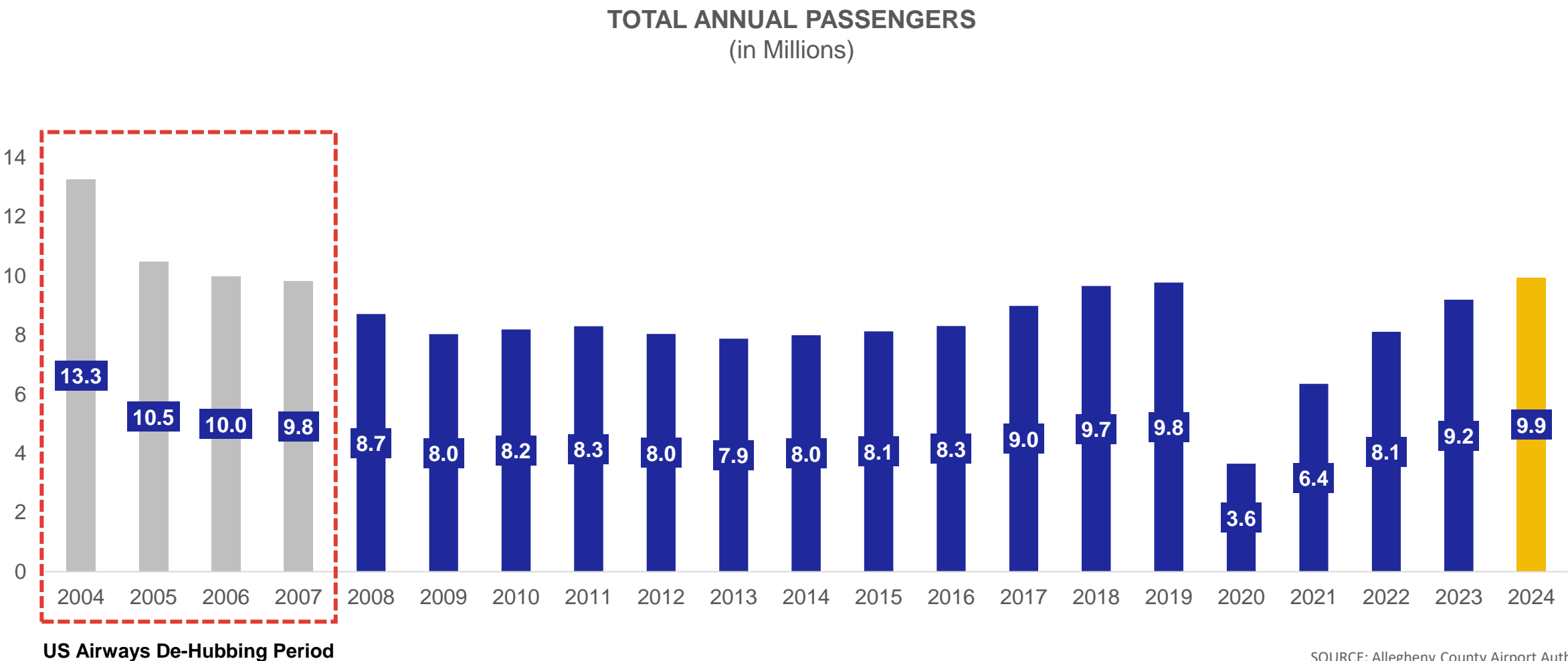

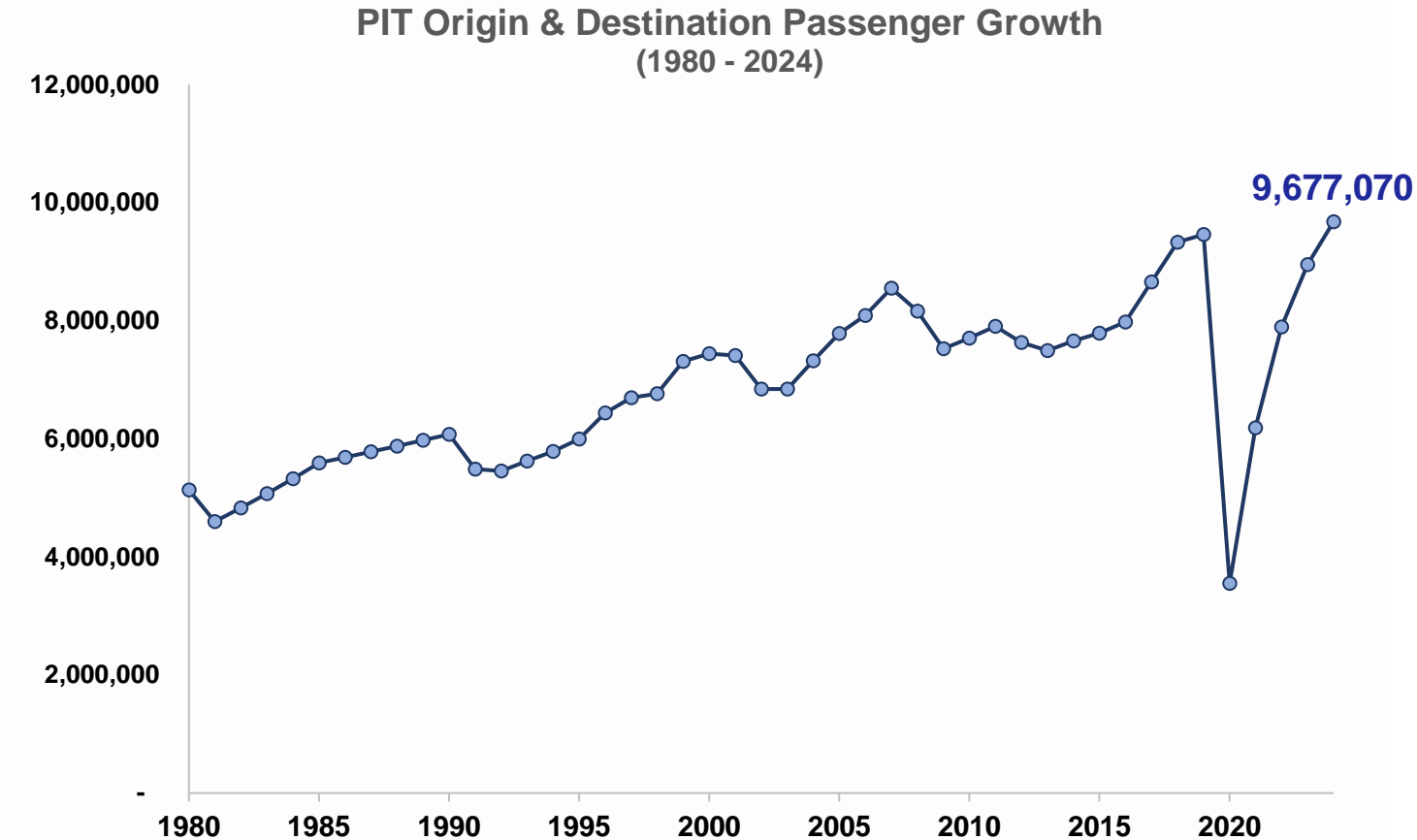
2024 saw the highest level of passenger traffic at PIT since the late US Airways de-hubbing period

JetBlue will launch service on April 30 to New York JFK from PIT

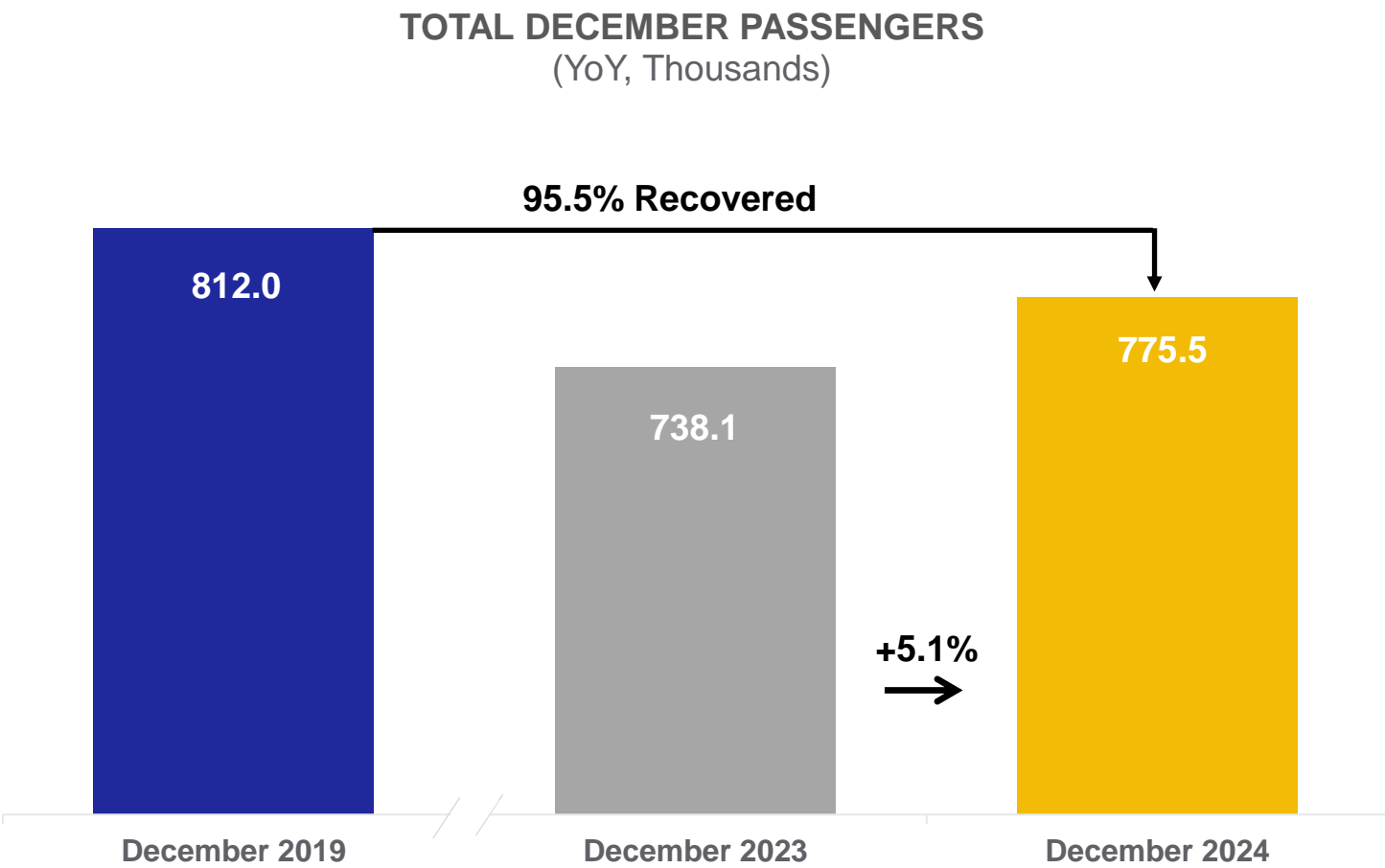


Service will launch with one daily departure

JetBlue will provide excellent connectivity to numerous Caribbean destinations via JFK

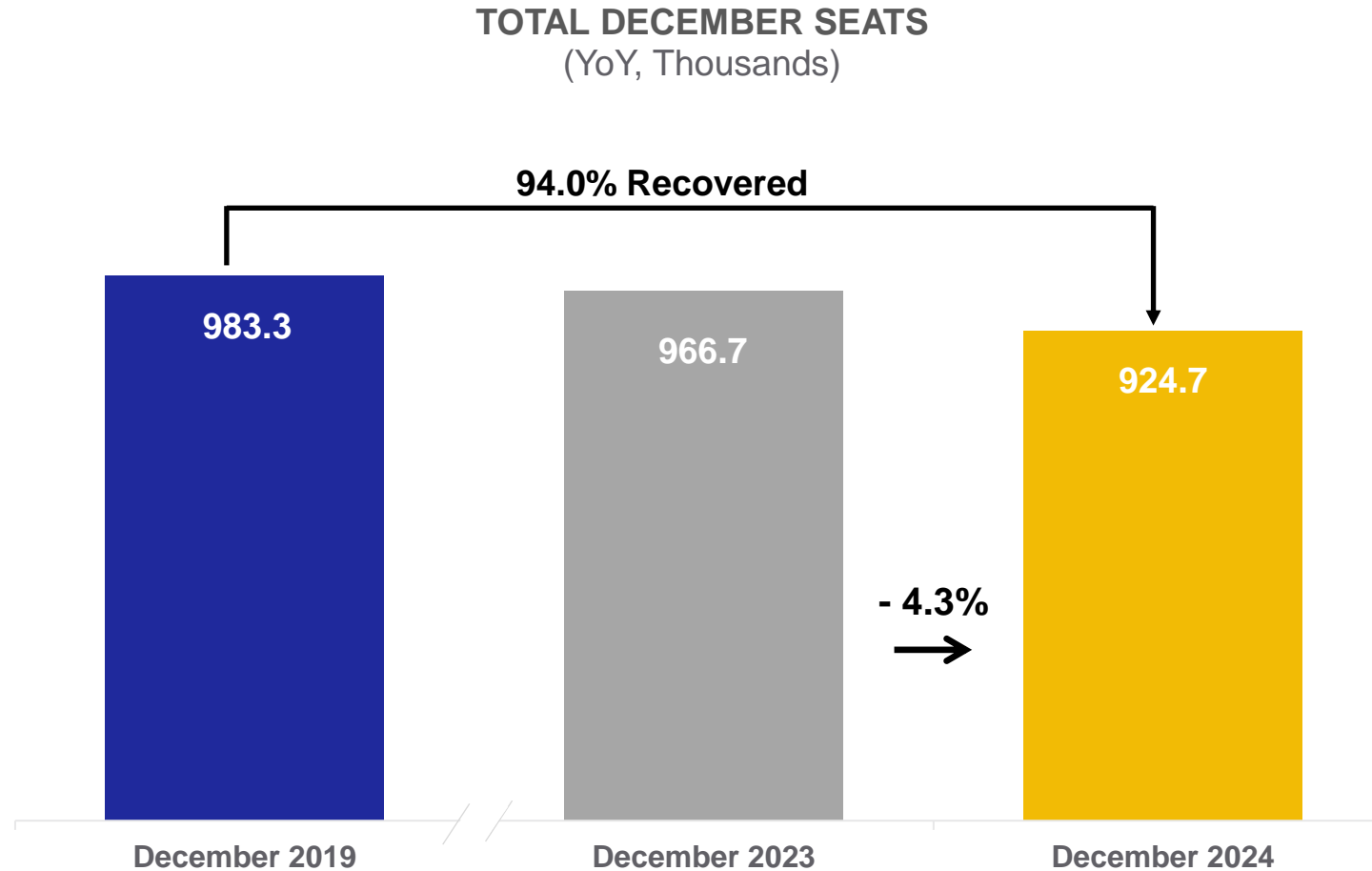
December 2024 passenger traffic was the busiest for that month since 2019

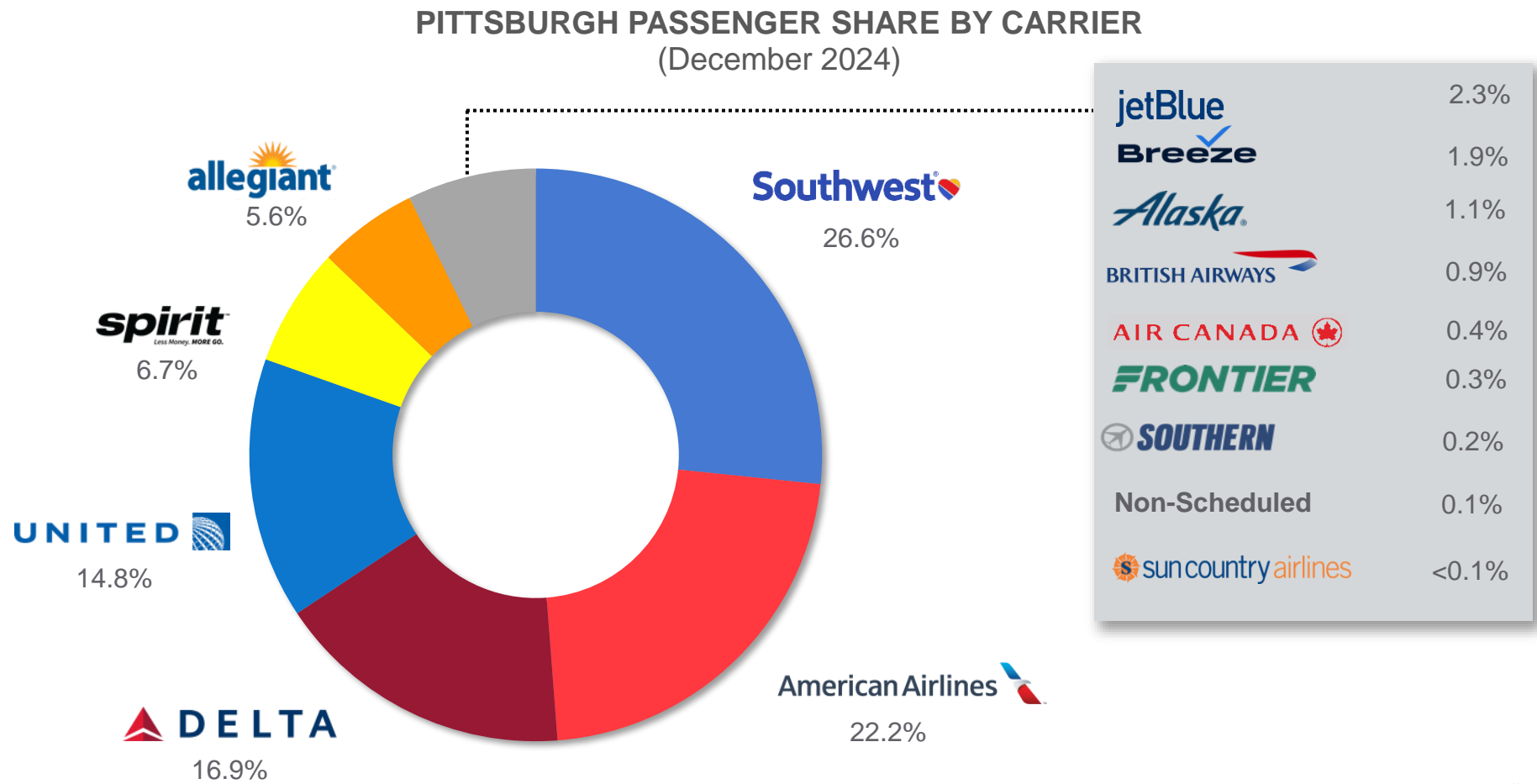


Total passenger capacity declined year-over-year due to adjustments made by low- and ultra-low-cost carriers



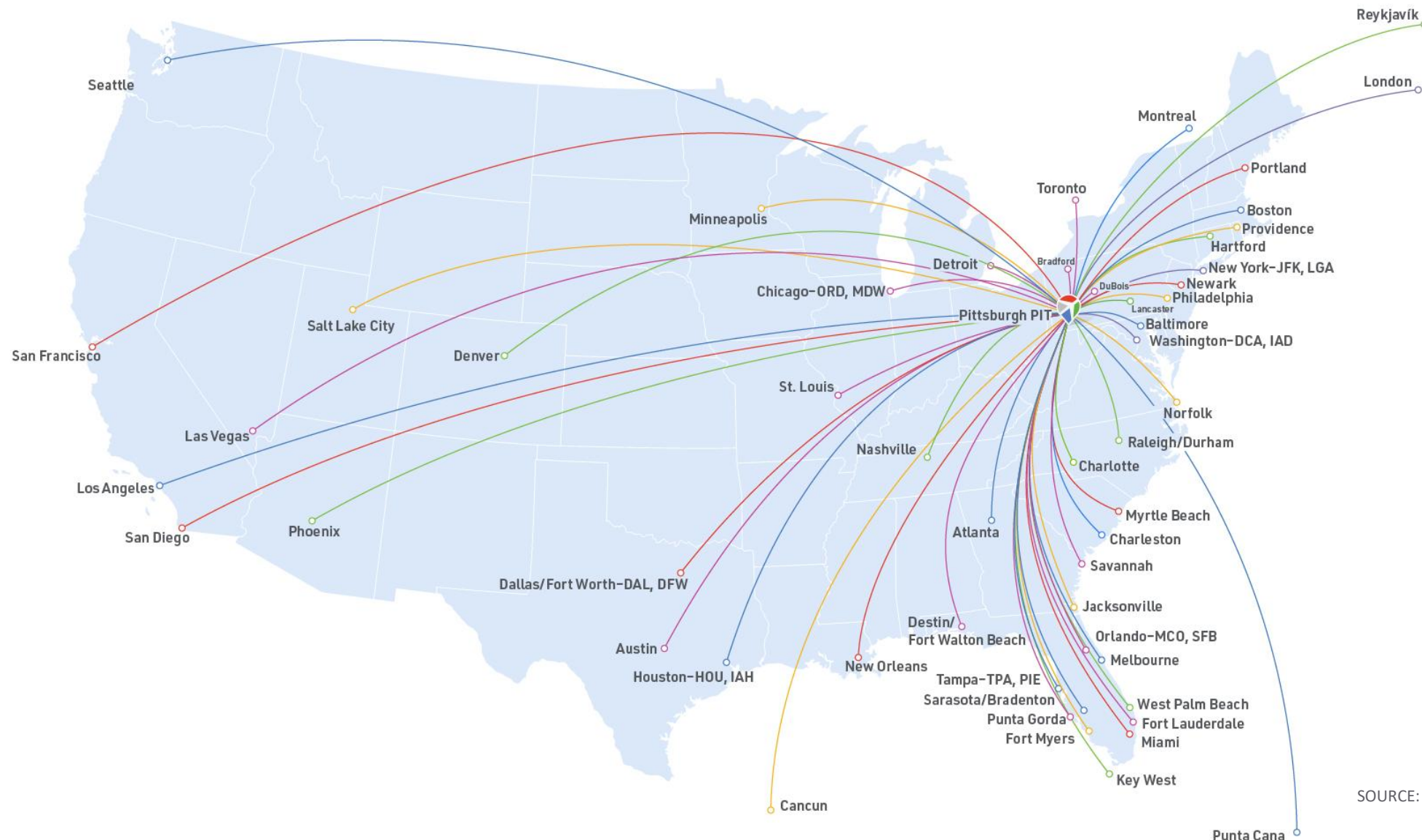

Southwest continues to hold the leading market share position at PIT



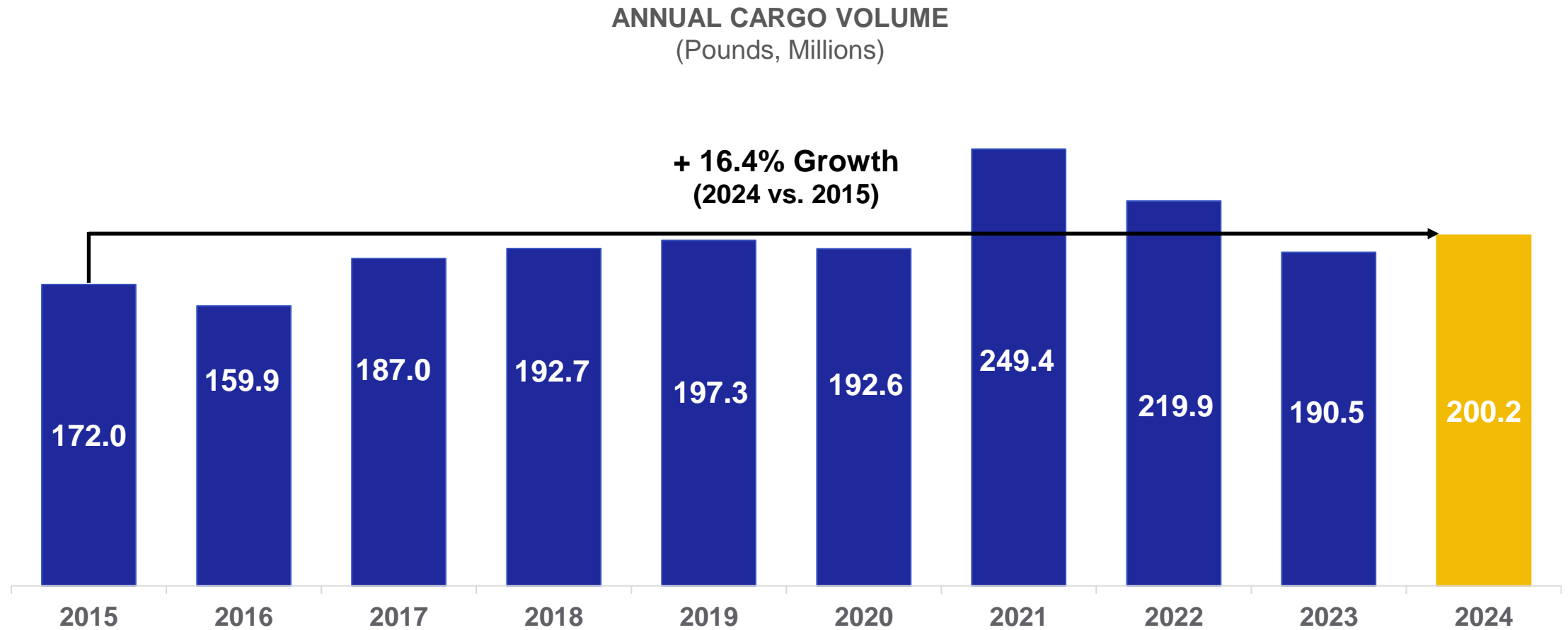

PIT currently has nonstop service to 61 destinations with 134 peak-day departures



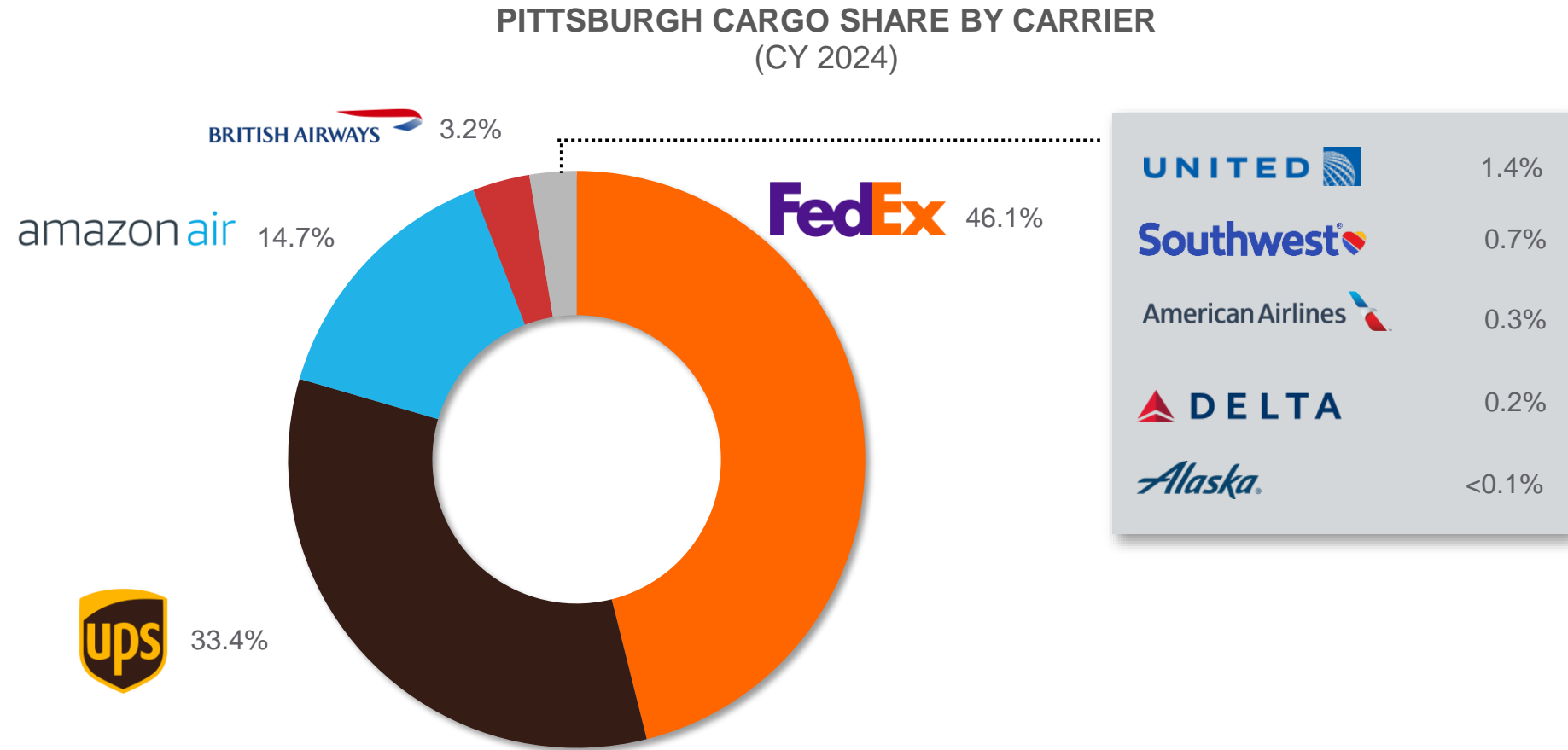

Air cargo at PIT increased in 2024 by over 16% compared to 2015 and has surpassed 2019 levels



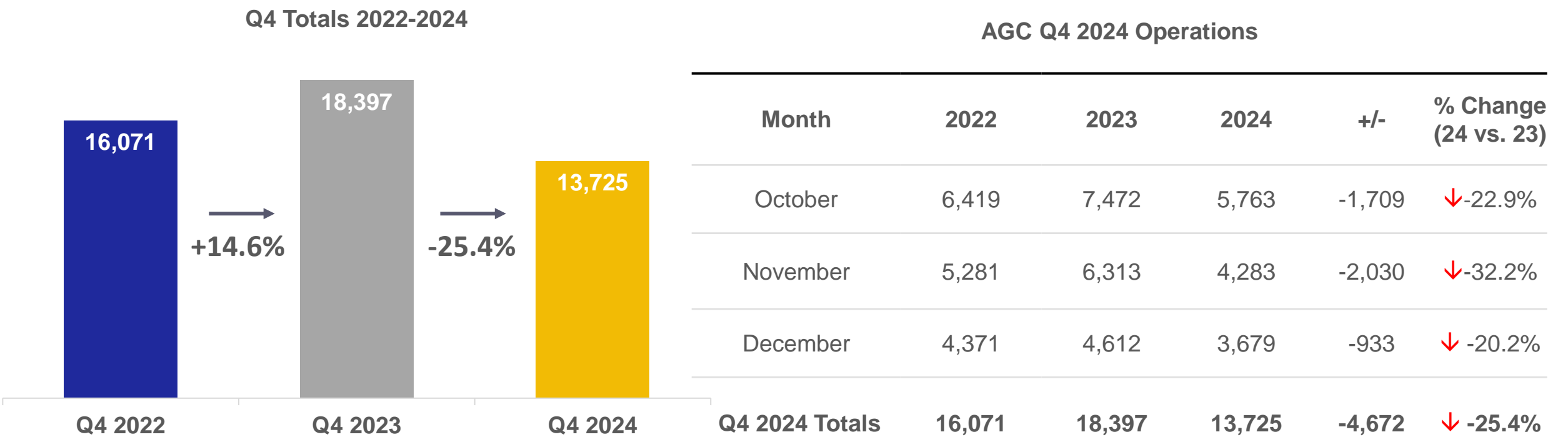

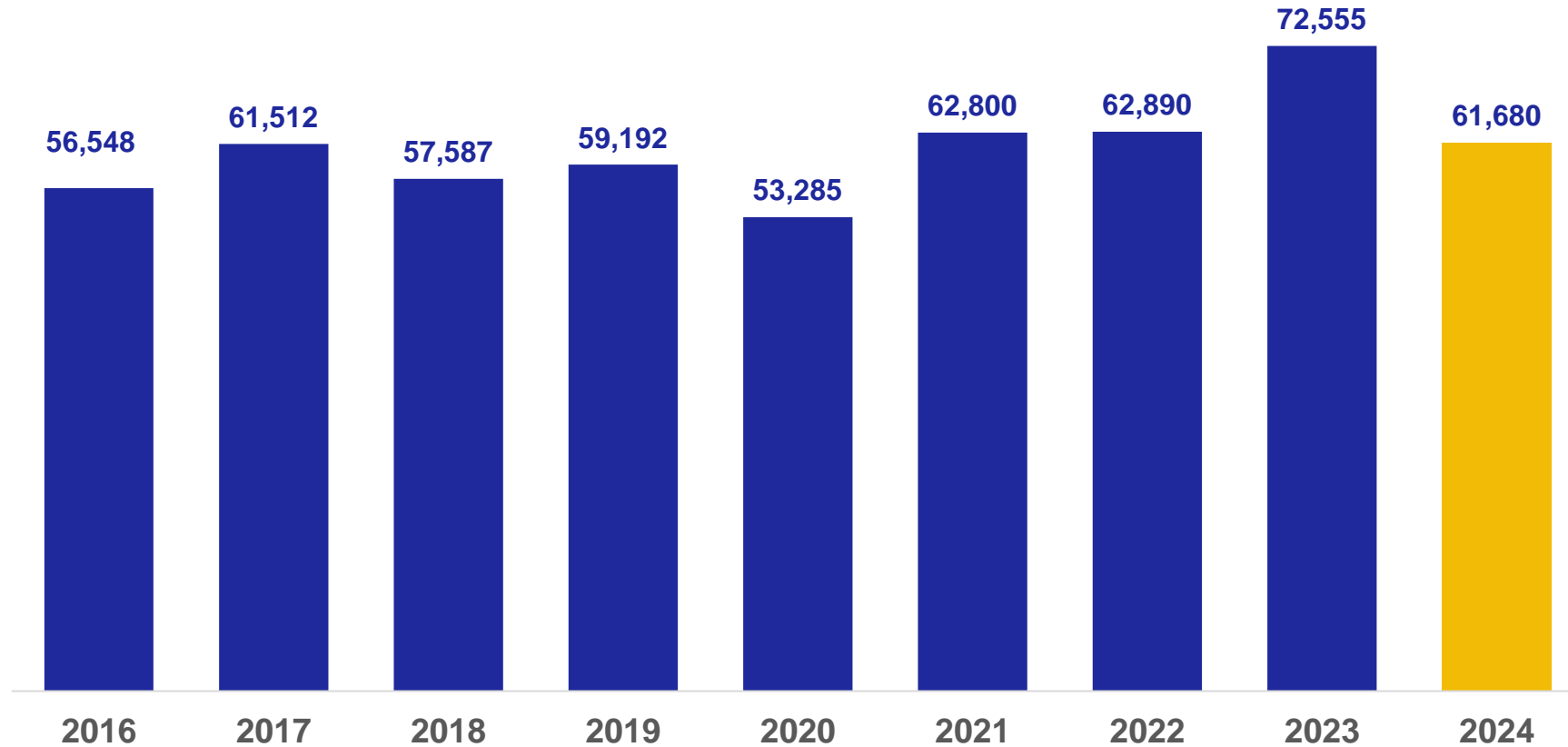
AGC air traffic in the fourth quarter of 2024 saw a 25% decrease when compared to the previous year

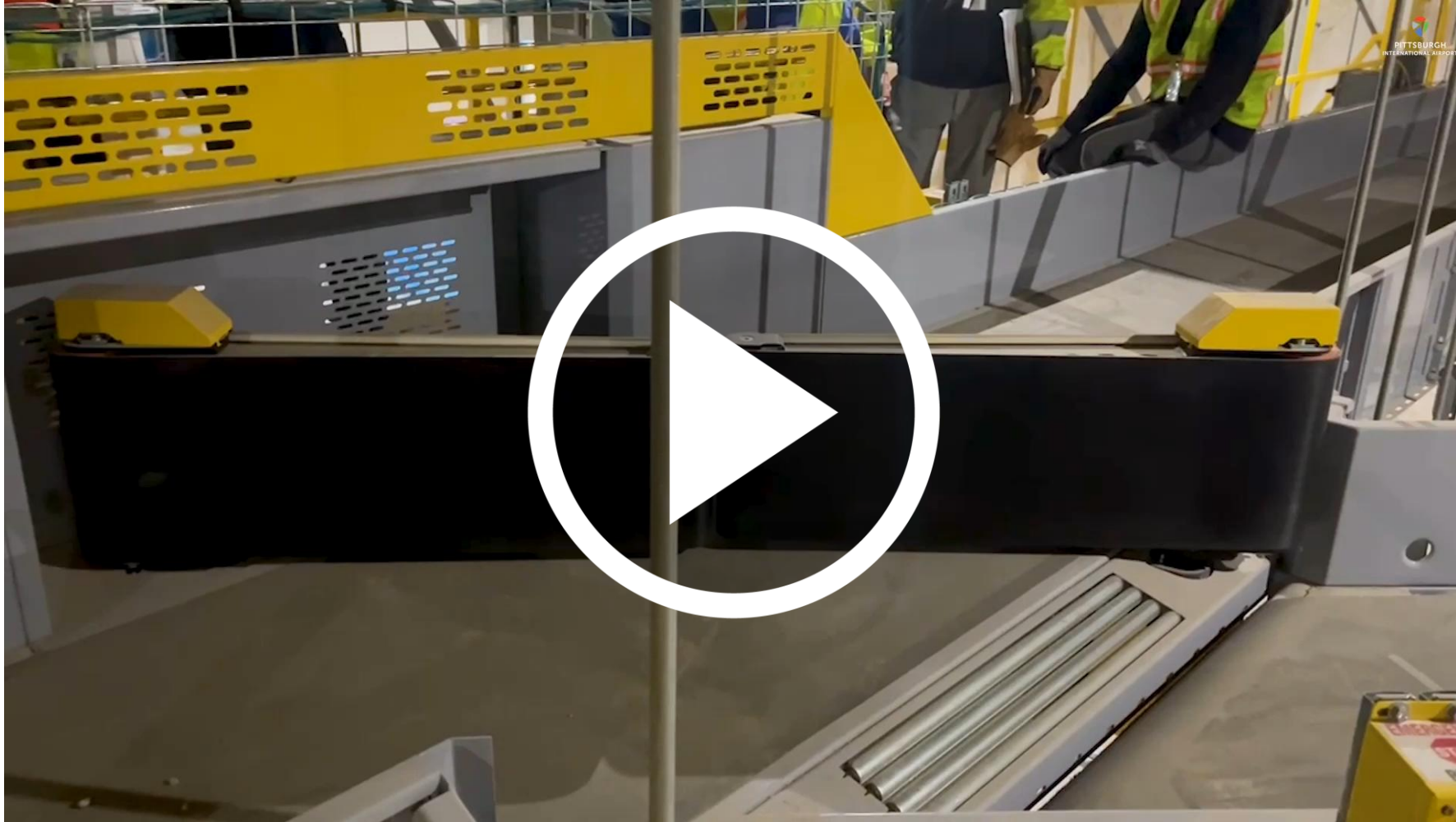

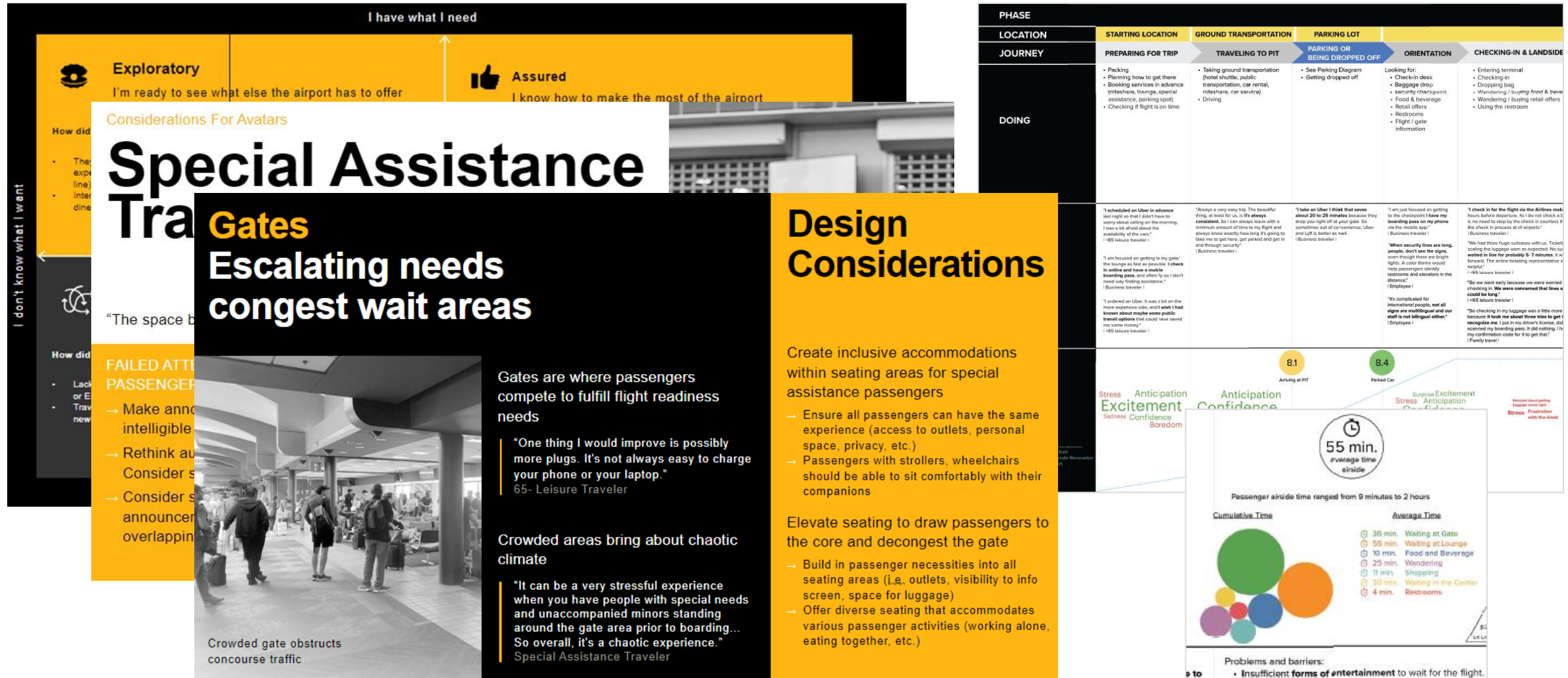
