



Travel demand remains strong with passenger traffic at PIT achieving the busiest September since 2004




September scheduled capacity grew over 12%, the busiest September in terms of scheduled seats since 2006

TOTAL SEPTEMBER SEATS (YoY, Thousands) 110.6% Recovered 1,100




PIT passenger traffic is realizing its busiest year-to-date total since 2007

PIT now has nonstop service to 62 destinations with 162 peak-day departures




A Pavilion in Penn's Woods


