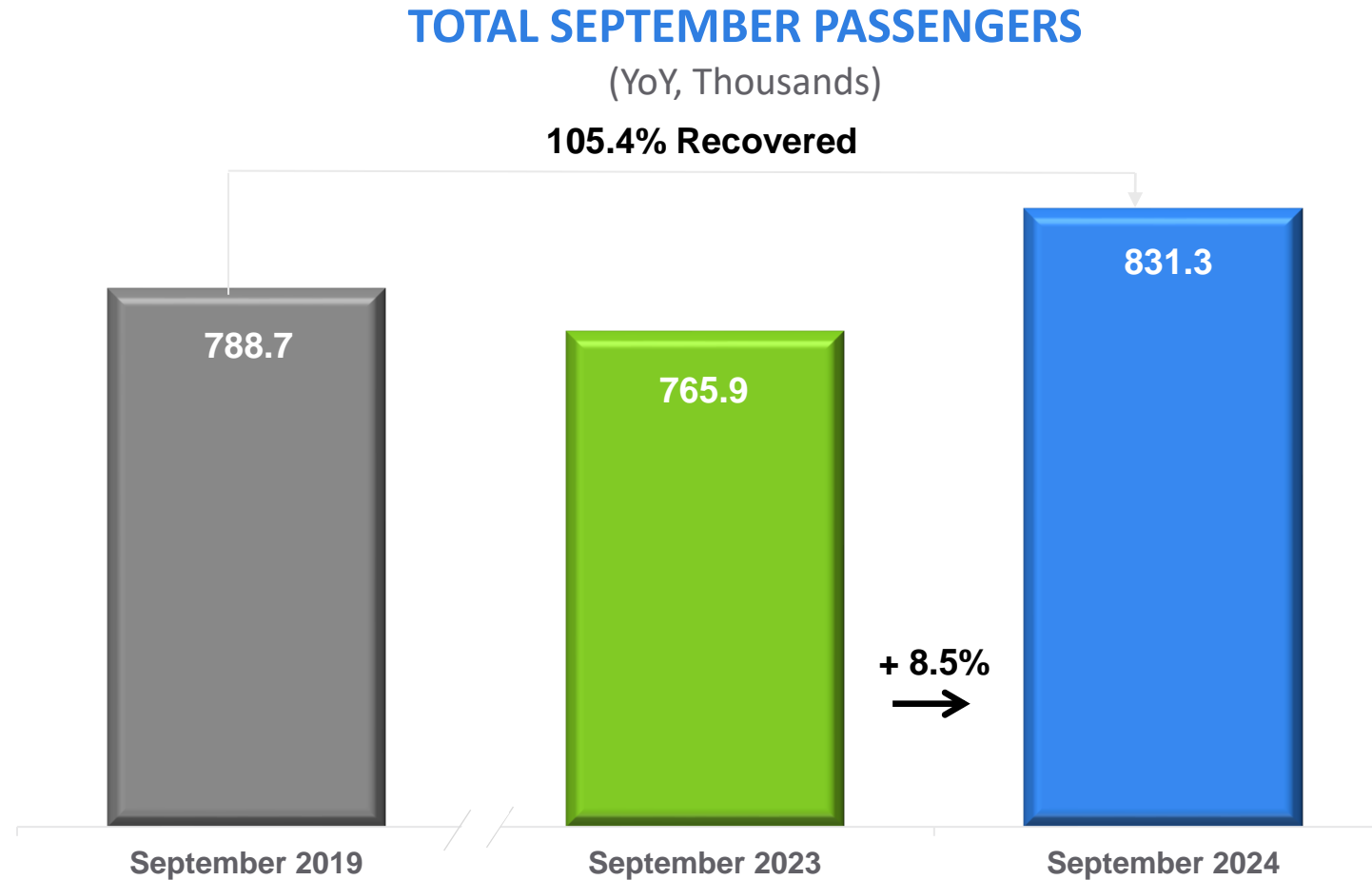

# Travel demand remains strong with passenger traffic at PIT achieving the busiest September since 2004

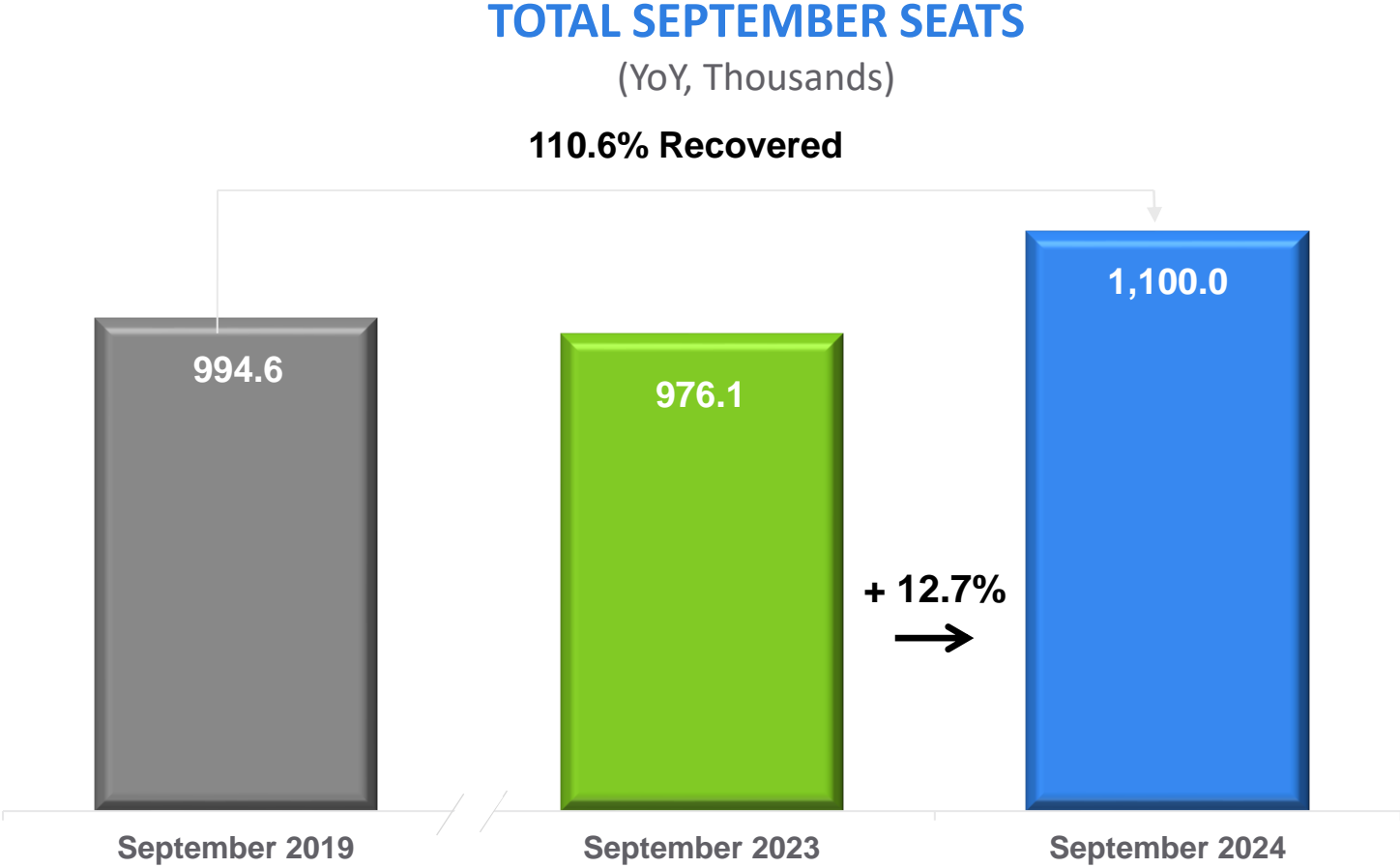

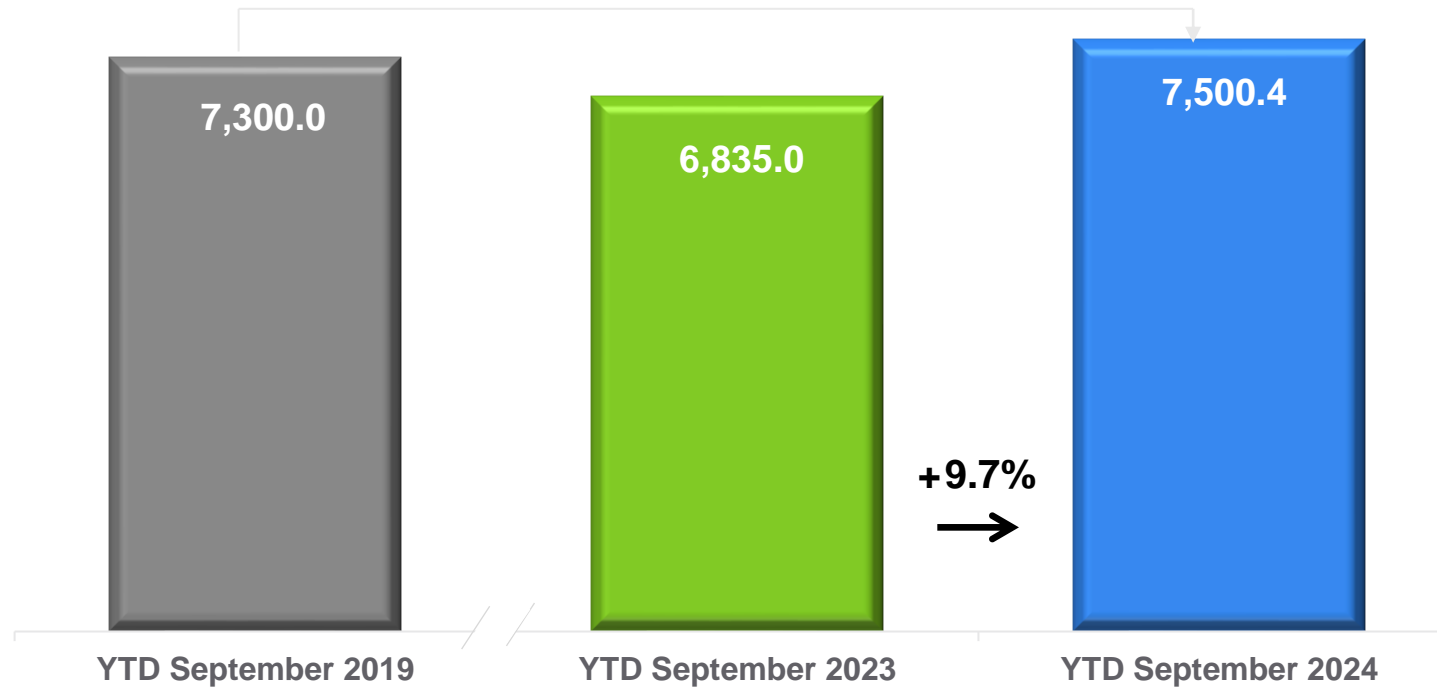


# PIT passenger traffic is realizing its busiest year-to-date total since 2007

102.7% Recovered



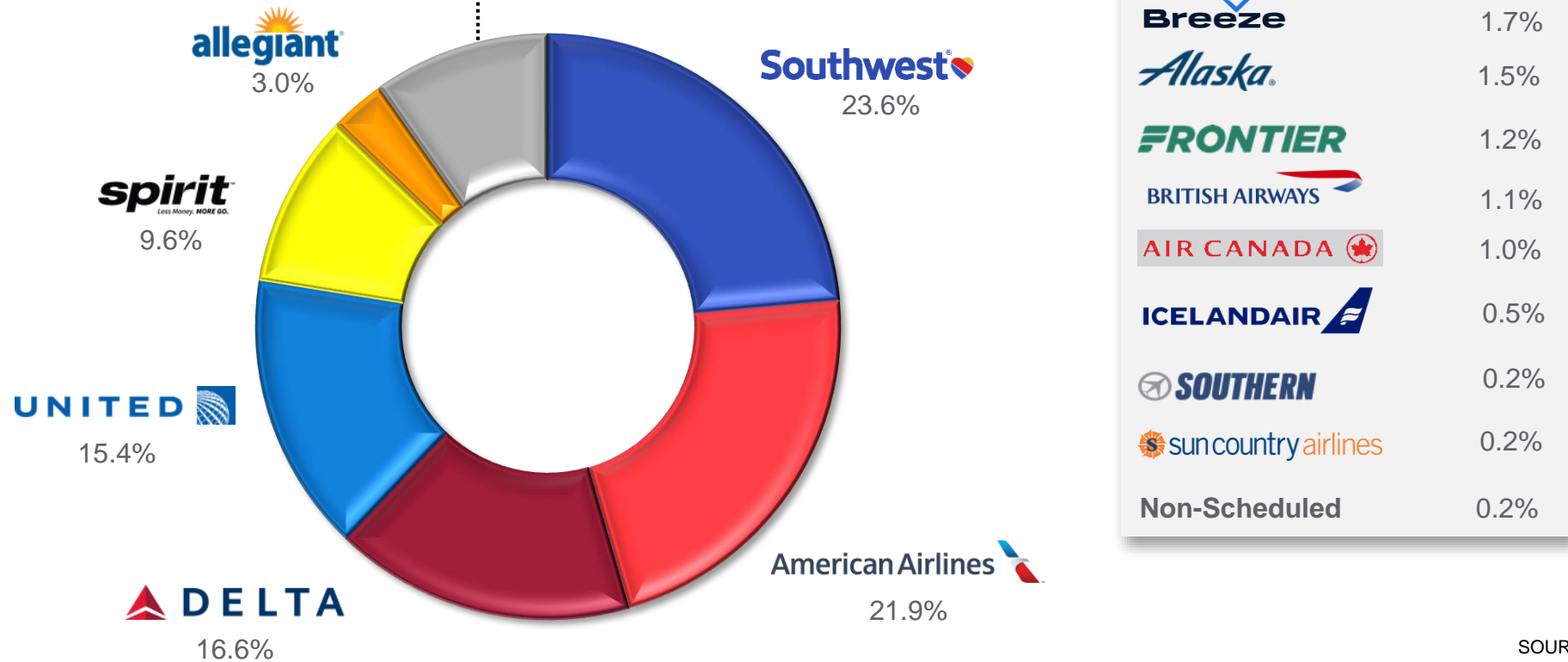

## PITTSBURGH PASSENGER SHARE BY CARRIER

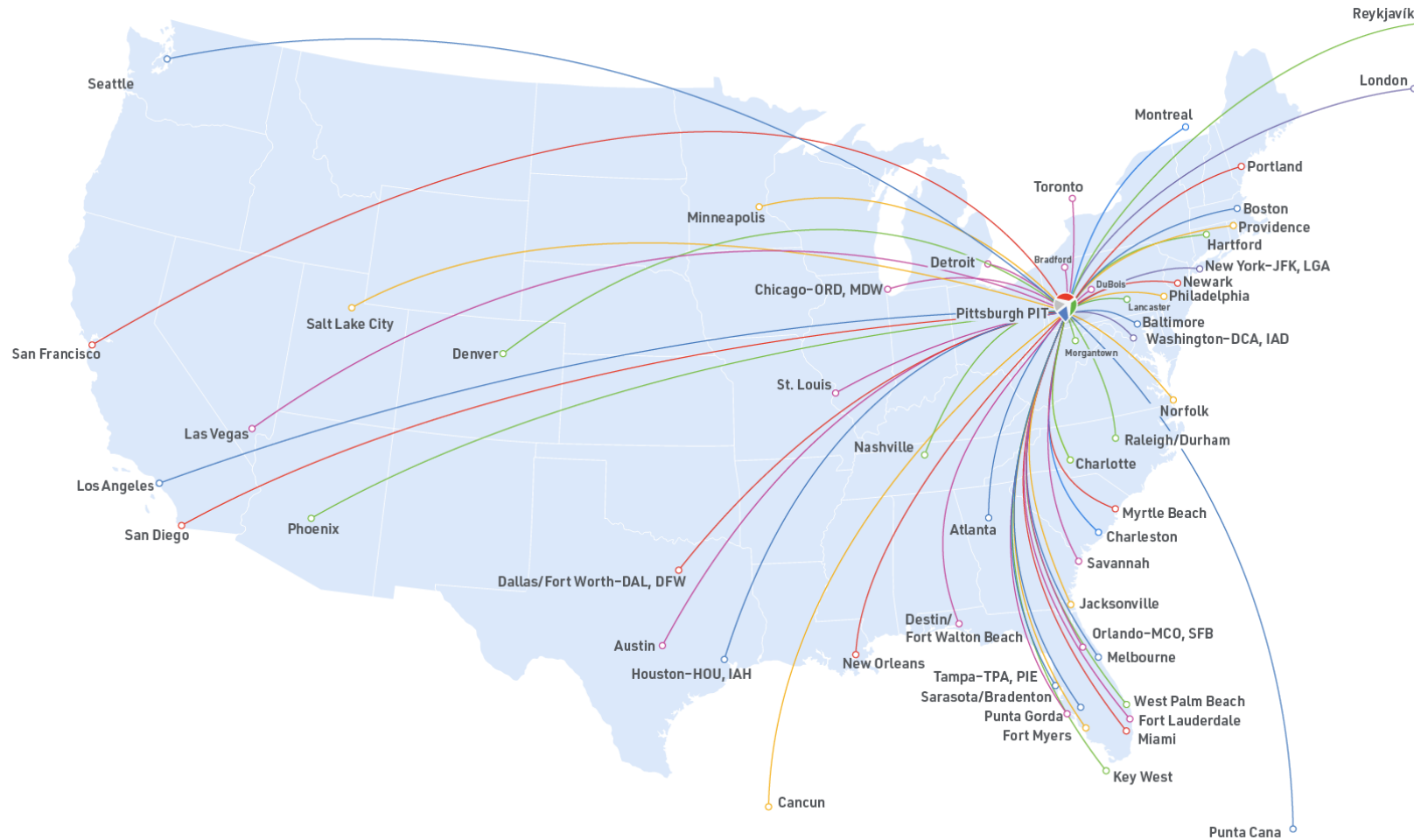

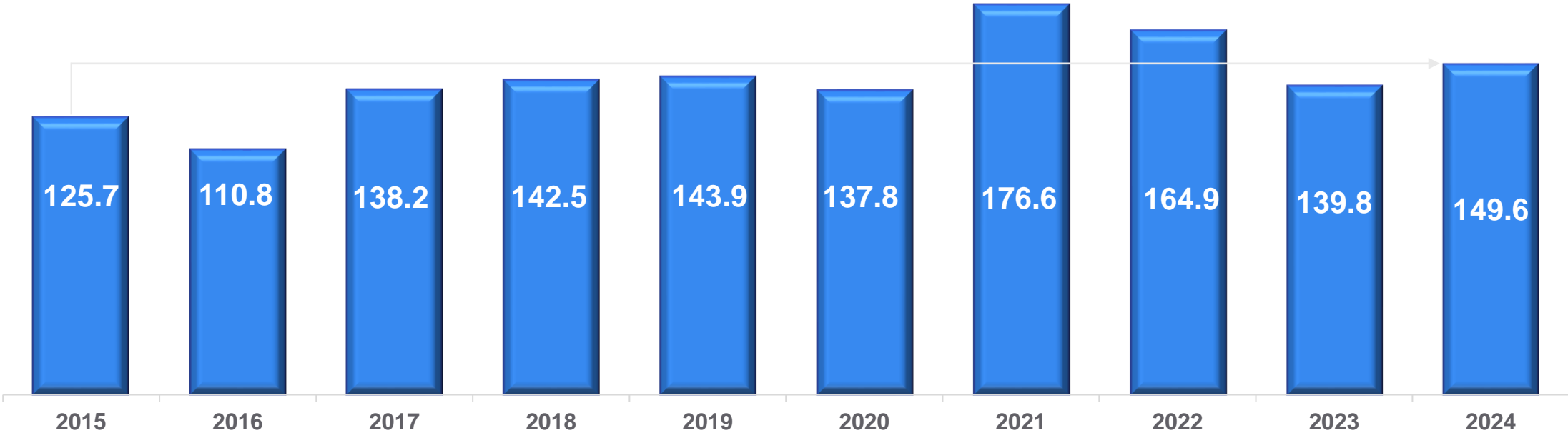


# Year-to-date September 2024 air cargo at PIT increased 19% versus 2015 and is above 2019 levels

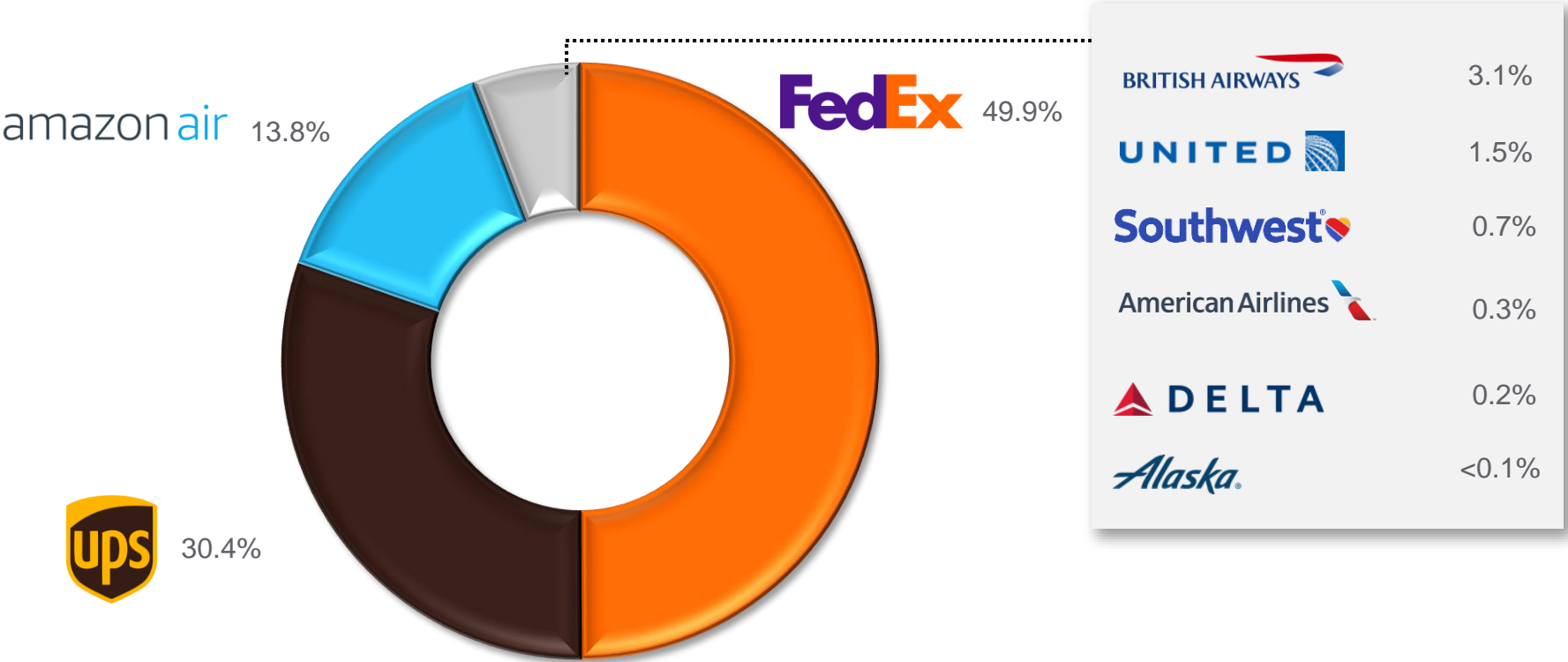




# FedEx, UPS and AmazonAir maintain the majority share of cargo at PIT

Guided by the principle of **biophilic design**, the new PIT is meant to be a pavilion set within Penn's Woods, providing visitors a relationship with the natural environment.







**Biophilic design** promotes connection between airport visitors and our community by creating a welcoming space that incorporates elements of Western PA's natural environment into the structures we are building.

As we set a design standard, we are also reimagining how an airport supports our environment

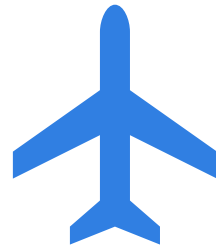
