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February marks 10 years for Allegiant at PIT – the airline kickstarted in-market ULCC growth

In 10 years, Allegiant has carried approximately **3.2 million passengers** to and from PIT

Allegiant serves **14 nonstop destinations** from PIT, including 9 in Florida – the most of any airline

Allegiant's PIT crew base has a **major economic impact** - employing dozens of local pilots, flight attendants, and maintenance professionals


2025 is off to a strong start as airlines continue to add new flights to key destinations

TOTAL JANUARY PASSENGERS




Airline capacity declined year-over-year due to adjustments made by several carriers

TOTAL JANUARY SEATS (YoY, Thousands)





PIT currently has nonstop service to 62 destinations with 144 peak-day departures




The new PIT incorporates the nature of the region, the technology of our innovation economy and our community

It is a priority for our team to ensure that travelers see Pittsburgh in the shopping and dining offerings




Local businesses selling local products reflect the Pittsburgh community in an important way
