How Did That Get There? – March 10, 2025

How do you get big pieces of construction material to the middle of the airside terminal?

Well, in the case of these escalators, you bring them right down the concourse.

Construction workers moved these 12,000-pound, 30-foot-long pieces of the new escalators for the center core through the terminal overnight last week. In total, four new escalators will be installed to accommodate foot traffic from the new terminal as passengers will be led through the connector bridge and onto the mezzanine level of the core.

Eight total pieces—two per new escalator—will be moved through the terminal this month, starting at the end of Concourse D after being staged on the airfield from delivery.

The work was done overnight to ensure minimal delays or inconveniences for concessionaires and passengers, making this another example of successful coordination to keep the airport running at full speed.
